Old Business

Van Newstrom, who chaired the meeting, provided an update on the Park Enhancement Program proposals. The next draft is due to the County on August 22. Building permit for 619 South 19th Street South

Mark Hutto solicited AHCA support for a building permit for 619 S 19th St. A motion to take no action at this time was approved. The topic will be addressed at the September AHCA meeting. Neighborhood Conservation (NC) Plan

Steve Wyner provided a summary of the draft NC Plan, noting it was the first update since 1970. He said the plan, if approved by the AHCA, will next go through as series of reviews by County organizations. He will keep us informed as the plan goes through the County process. Mr. Wyner recommended that the AHCA establish a process for regular review and update of individual sections of the NC Plan.

Members discussed the draft plan and the manner in which it was put together. A motion to delay a vote on the plan until the September meeting was defeated. A motion to approve the draft NC plan to go through the County process was approved.
