**Sin & Saint.** This new neighborhood establishment, in the former Grill Kabob location at 23<sup>rd</sup> and Eads, has applied for a use permit for a DeeJay and dancing on Fridays and Saturdays. The applicant and County staff will be at the meeting to discuss the application and answer questions.

**Virginia Highlands Park Renovation.** Arlington's Capital Improvement Plan included funding to begin public outreach in anticipation of west-side park renovations (everything west of the soccer fields). Parks & Rec staff will be at our meeting to talk about the best way to engage the community in the redesign process (funding is not yet available for the design). It was only a year ago that the newly renovated east side reopened after a frustrating public engagement process that left many feeling that community input had been disregarded. Please come and let DPR know how you feel about the park and how you want them to get public input.

**Christian Dorsey.** One of the two newest members of the County Board, Mr. Dorsey will be at the meeting to talk about his priorities, hear about yours, and listen to the DPR's presentation on Virginia Highland Park. Come with your questions.

## Community Updates

**School Board Candidate Update.** On March 16th the Arlington Ridge Civic Association, in a joint effort with AHCA and CCCA, hosted a Candidate Forum for the three Democratic candidates running for the open seat on the APS School Board. James Lander (incumbent), Maura McMahan, and Monique O'Grady each spoke about their vision for how to improve instruction, communication, and the capacity crisis within APS. **Elections.** Still energized by the 2016 elections? Wishing you didn't have to wait till 2018 to feel that election buzz again? Well, you're in luck. Virginia is only one of two states (the other being New Jersey) with a gubernatorial election the year after the Presidential election, providing, as the Election Law Society puts it, "a quick fix for the electoral junkie who didn't quite get enough the last go around." In addition to the governor, we will be holding elections for all statewide offices and, in Arlington, for municipal offices including County Board and School Board. The General Election will be November 7, but before that there will be Democratic and Republican primaries for statewide offices on June 13, and a Democratic caucus for County Board and School Board on May 9, 11, and 13. The Democratic County Board candidates will participate in a debate at 8:15 on April 12 at Marymount University's Gerard Phelan Hall.
