Melwood's Special GLUP Amendment

Based on the vote held at our special meeting we recommended the Planning commission (1) reject the Tier II Study, (2) retain public use of the site, (3) consider the AHCA alternate example which prioritizes green space, appropriate scale, and historic preservation, (4) delay all GLUP Studies until the process can be reviewed. The County Board in January acknowledged the need to study the special GLUP process.

AHCA's Stacy Meyer has spearheaded an effort to meet with each planning commissioner to share our concerns. Staff's Planning Commission Draft Report mentions many of our questions but does not resolve the concerns raised.

Please continue to make your thoughts known to the County and attend the Planning Commission May 6 and the County Board May 20, 2024. Registration to speak May 6 closes Sunday night.

Elections June 18- Don't forget to vote!

Dual Primary June 18 - Arlington County is holding an a dual primary on Tuesday, June 18. The Democratic Party is selecting a candidate for the County Board election this fall, and the Republican Party is selecting a US Senate candidate for the fall election.

Virginia does not require party registration to vote in primaries. Arlington voters may vote in **either** primary, but **not both**. This County <u>voting page</u> provides key information on both primaries, including the candidate names for each party ballot.

The Democratic Primary election will again be by ranked choice. You may rank up to 3 of the 5 Democratic candidates on your ballot. More information on how ranked choice voting works can be found here. This page also links to a sample ranked choice ballot to practice this type of voting.

Register to vote (or update your existing voter registration) by May 28. If you miss the registration deadline, you may be able to do <u>Same Day Registration</u>.

Changes to the Neighborhood

JBG Smith announced that it is closing all retail in the Underground in Crystal City. You might wonder what is the plan? So do we. JBG Smith has not shared any details with us despite our monthly community updates with them. This in combination with the recent cancellation of the Crystal City Library Branch has raised concerns over JBG Smith's plans for the community and what sort of presence it intends to have. The retail stores are to be closed by October. Currently it is unknown what will become of the space but the pedestrian passage will remain open. It is unclear what will become of the galleries/artist space in the Underground. Many in December's Livability's priority meeting suggested the space could house community programs, but we have not heard of this idea gaining any traction.

The Arlington County Board voted Saturday, April 20, 2024, to adopt a \$1.65 billion balanced budget for Fiscal Year 2025, a 6.4 percent increase over FY 2024.
