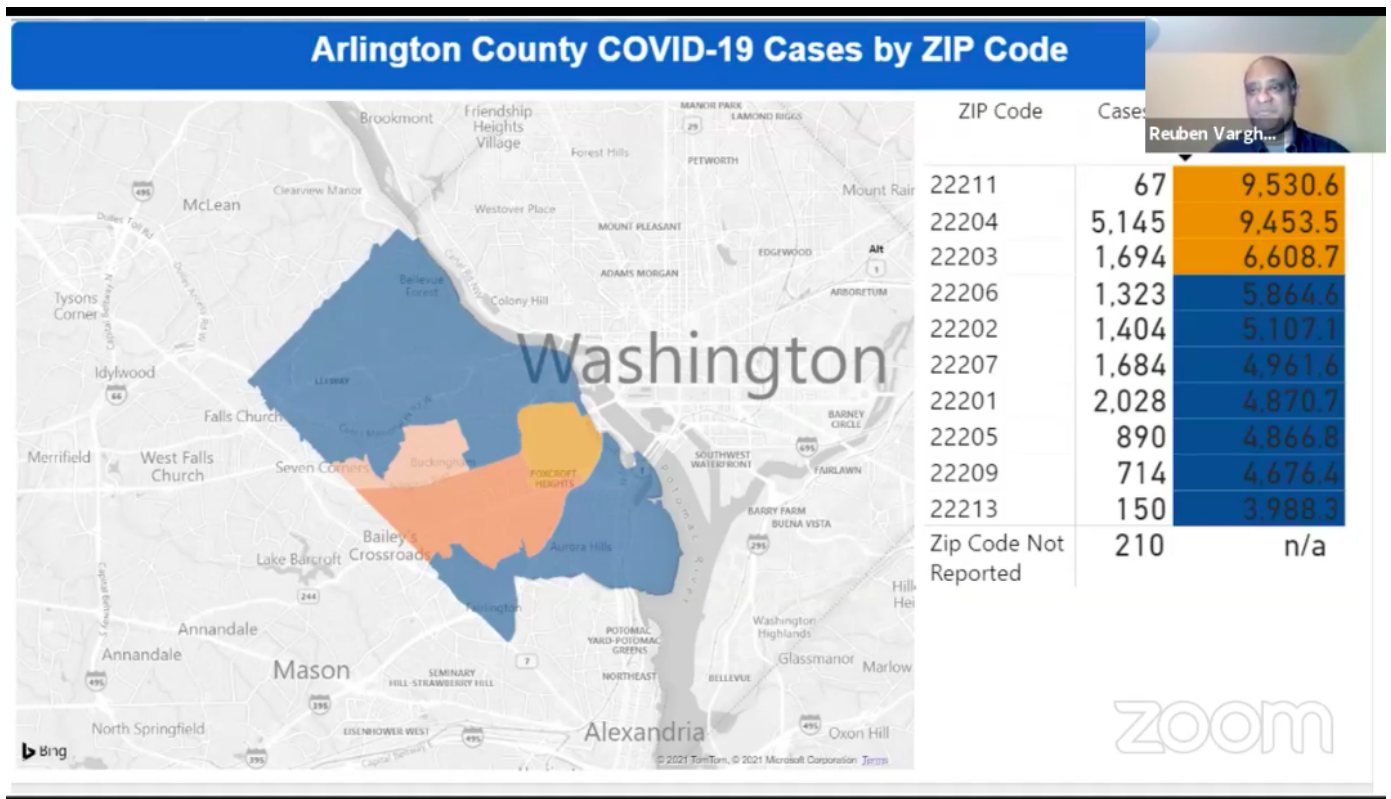
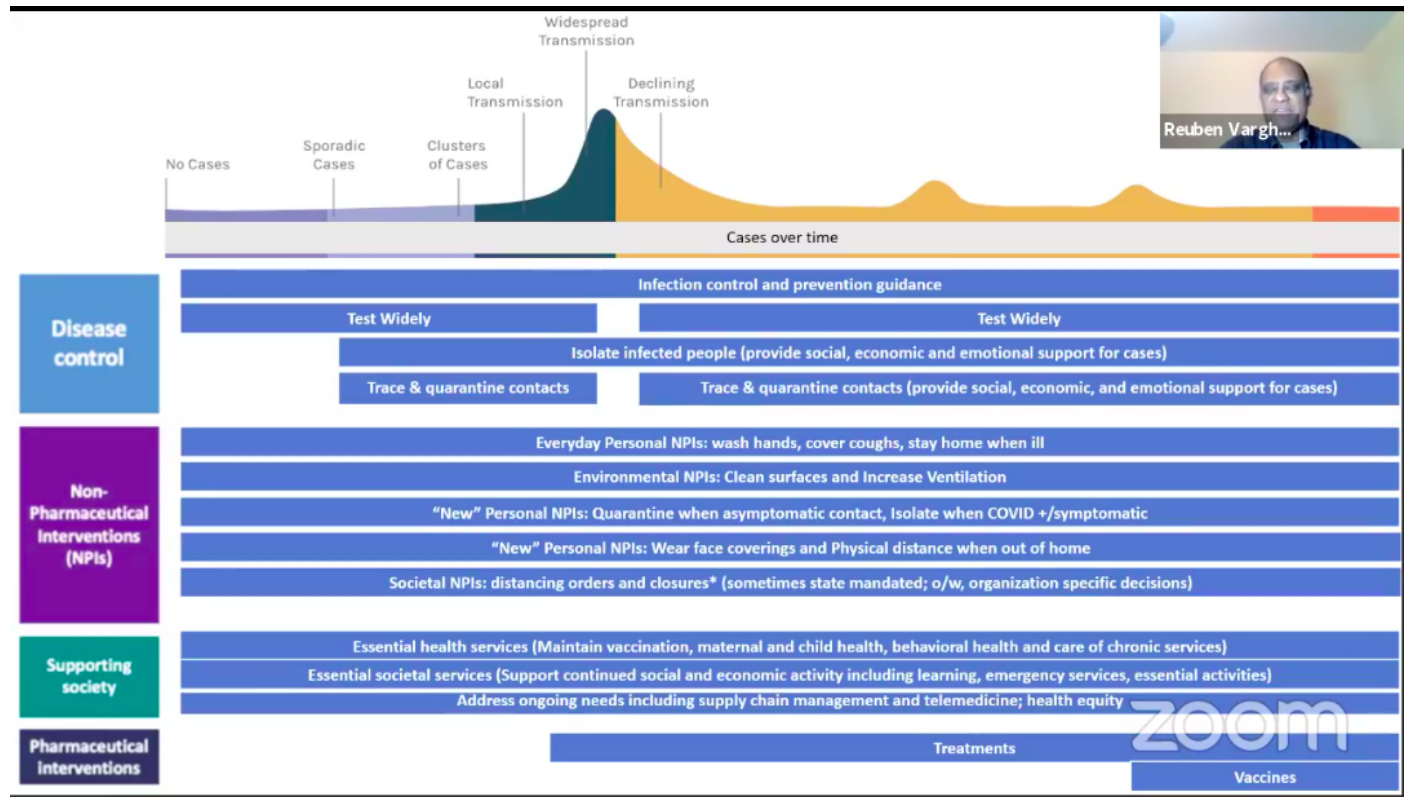

There was an estimated 15,214 cases of COVID in Arlington (and counting), this graph shows the number of cases per zip code.



This graph shows components of the COVID response and outlines a general depiction of how cases are handled.



Dr. Varghese said that vaccinations *will* help end this pandemic quicker but still keep your guard up as in parts of the World the pandemic is still raging. This is the greatest undertaking since WW2 mobilization.
